I also acknowledge the present blessing of a parish such as ours, which I believe is so vital to not only Berrien County but also to the Diocese of Kalamazoo. I am confidently pleased to know our future looks bright as new families make their welcomed presence known in our parishes. We should all be able to see so clearly that the good work begun in our parish life continues to manifest itself in this proud community of Roman Catholic Christians.

With that said, it is time for me to say thank you to each and everyone who took the time to share a card, a word of encouragement, a plate of homemade goodies, and the myriad of other kind gifts that I and my staff received and also to all of the "quiet angels" in our parish who each day provide so much to the edification, and well-being of our community. To help maintain anonymity and guarantee no one feels slighted I will let you in on some of the things our quiet angels can take pride in having accomplished. Our bulletins are the result of the work of a parishioner who took on the task of securing the advertisements which help pay for each weekend publication. Thank you. The beautiful decorations each Christmas and Easter have been the result of your generosity and a team of individuals who pool all sorts of resources to provide the noble simplicity of our worship space décor. We have been additionally blessed that after recognizing the tattered, battered, and worn condition of our outdoor nativity set, a benefactor provided the crisp, clean, brightly illumined set that now adorns the Lake Street side of the Bridgman parish. Thank you.

The parking lots at both churches have been repayed to help extend the life of

the lots and thus avoid, at least for the next five years, the exorbitant cost of resurfacing each lot. Key persons at both churches helped me negotiate through the repavement process. Thank you. The side Altars and statues have been installed; thank you to the individuals who offered their time and talent to that project. Only a few minor details remain on this project before Mass can properly be offered at those spaces.

Special quiet angels provided funding, time, and talent to minor roof repairs at the rectory, and the awnings of the church to redirect water drainage. Thank you. Benefactors have also provided for the newly installed carpet on the Lake Street stairs, and additional generosity will enable us to replace the stairs carpet on the steps facing the Al Tio Center, as soon as the weather warms.

Confirming, just as St. Paul notes, that all things work together for the good to those who love the Lord and are called according to His purpose; I want to say thank you to the staff person and special assistant who replaced the Sanctuary's carpeting with wood laminate and acknowledge their labor and professionalism. Thank you also to a parish family who donated funding, time, labor, and a team of associates who were able to replace subflooring in the sanctuary, which allowed everything to "fall" into place.
