-- The Pastor's Corner --

The attendance at this past week's "wing and a prayer" Eucharistic Adoration made me do the "happy happy joy joy dance"; something that not even the weird commercials, Beyonce, nor the blackout from last week's Super Bowl was able to accomplish.

We are only a few days away from entrance into the somber liturgical season of Lent. It is therefore time for us to prepare for reflection, in a profound way, on our relationship with God. We should not want to begin this Lenten season in the same old way, reflecting only on the things we wish to give up, instead of thinking of the things we need to accomplish to be closer to God. I therefore plan to use every prayer tool at my disposal to assist each member of our parish communities in a renewal of the Lenten journey.

On Tuesday of this coming week, for what I believe is the first time in our parish history, we will gather to celebrate "Mardi Gras". I realized recently that not many of our members, young or old, knew much of the tradition of the Fat Tuesday celebration. Tuesday will be our introduction into the tradition of making a joyful noise prior to taking that first step into the forty days of Lent. Ash Wednesday is not considered a Holy Day of Obligation, however I want each of you to feel as though your souls could be in mortal danger should you fail to attend Mass on that day. Likewise, for each of the Fridays during Lent we will pray the Stations of the Cross followed by a few brief moments in Eucharistic Adoration. Although attendance for the Stations of the Cross has been good in past years, I am exhorting, calling upon, prompting, hoping, maybe even begging some of you to double, if not triple your attendance this year. Praying the Stations not only gives us the opportunity to receive the plenary indulgence; it also affords us the chance to walk the road of Calvary with our Savior, Jesus Christ. The images of Christ walking to Golgotha which, although they hang on the walls of our church and we have virtually ignored all vear, are now dusted off. In some churches they sing, "walk together children, don't you get weary", we are going to bring that hymn to life each Friday during Lent.

Far too many of us have lost some of the discipline of truly living and practicing our Catholic faith. In fact, we love calling ourselves Catholic unless or until being Catholic requires anything more from us than attending Sunday Mass. I therefore want you to pause right now and reflect on the scripture passage, which tells us "to whom much is given, much is required".

As a bulletin insert this weekend you will find the Lenten regulations. Do not toss them aside, but prayerfully observe them as you reflect on how miniscule our obligations are in comparison to what Jesus did so willingly for us.
