# -- The Pastor's Corner --

My brothers and sisters in Christ, Earlier this week, several of the priests in our Deanery met, by order of Bishop Bradley, to discuss the Bishop's Annual Appeal. One of the pastors was able to proudly report that his parish had not only met their assessed goal of more than \$130,000, but that his church had exceeded their goal by more than \$30,000.

I was hit with the harsh reality that our parishes have fallen short, with St. Gabriel in need of \$3,000 to meet its assessed goal and Queen of Peace only at 50% of its \$27,000 assessed goal (and believe me it will be painful to sign the checks to the Diocese from our general fund to cover the difference). While it is true that we are living in very tough economic times, our failure to meet the goals is a sad testament to our ability to be good stewards. While it remains true that some of you have gone above and beyond your means to show your support of the Bishop's Appeal, and I thank you dearly for your effort and generosity, yet many of you have not as much as responded to the pledge cards. While I am a staunch believer that God provides everything we need, perhaps I should have been more insistent on 100% participation from each of you regarding the Bishop's Annual Appeal. Consider the following: If each family would annually pledge and donate just \$117, which could be divided into daily contributions of only about 33¢ per day, we could easily not only meet, but exceed our assessed annual appeal goals.

I will note it again that I am eternally grateful for those who have given, no matter what the amount. It is a confirmation that you understand the good work the Bishop's Annual Appeal enables our Diocese to accomplish. For example, let me remind you that our Diocese pays about \$150,000 for each seminarian who completes the minimal four years of theological training to become a priest. In June of this year, by God's grace and mercy, our Diocese hopes to ordain three men to the priesthood following their completion of seminary. You do the math. Please also note that approximately five of the current priest in our diocese will be retiring this summer. Again, you do the math. There will be five priests retiring and only three being ordained in a Diocese already suffering from a shortage of priests. Without priests their can be no Eucharist. The larger portion of the Bishop's Annual Appeal goes to support the education and training of seminarians for service as priests here in the Kalamazoo Diocese. Remember this is your Church, local, domestic, and universal.

When we stand before God in judgment, which each of us one day will do, will we hear Him say, "Good and faithful servant, well done", or will He be listening to our excuses for not doing what we should have, with the time, treasure, and talent He has given to us? Just think, only 33¢ a day, per family, above and beyond our tithes, will insure that we meet our annual appeal goals. Now that I have gotten the nastiness of my administrative duties out of the way. I want to encourage your hearts and minds in the love of God in Christ Jesus. This weekend we not only get to proclaim through our responsorial psalm that "The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with Joy", but for the first time at a Sunday Mass we collectively pray for and hear the name of our new Holy Father, Pope Francis mentioned. As the new Pontiff takes on the enormous task of shepherding the Church, let's not get caught in a desire to be complacent, but let us hope for something worthy of our calling as Catholic Christians.

Fr. Steiner wrote: "Isaiah tells us to dream of the good times in the past, but only for the purpose of believing that something better is coming". Isaiah lets God say to us, "See, I am doing something new! Now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?"

As we continue our introspection during these final days of Lent, let us forget what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead, continue our pursuit toward the goal, the prize of God's upward calling, in Christ Jesus. AMDG
