**-- The Pastor's Corner --**

My brothers and sisters in Christ, There was a hymn sung at my mother's church which repeated the phrase: "Lord I want to be a witness, witness, witness, witness". The phrase was sung over and over and over, until people were standing in the aisles of the church clapping their hands and screaming that they wanted to be witnesses. The experience made me want to scream out, what are you witnessing, that this song has no end?

We are instructed by Fr. Ed Steiner that today's pericope from Luke's gospel "is part of Jesus' farewell instructions to His disciples". "Luke uses two different words for witness in his Gospel, and both words translate into English simply as "witness." At the beginning of the Gospel the word means eyewitness, someone who actually saw something and then tells others about what was seen. The second word Luke use for witness is "martyr". This Greek word "martyr," is the one which we use for someone who dies for the faith, a profoundly different kind of witness. I again had the opportunity to consider our parish and what sort of "witness" we give as members of the Roman Catholic

Church. When we enter the Church would a live camera feed reveal a faithful servant of Christ Jesus, entering in reverent silence to speak to God, or would we just appear as a group of old gossips and scantily clad individuals who followed a crowd from the beach to church? Have we entered into the Lord's temple to celebrate the source and summit of our faith, or have we just stopped by to "punch the clock" and fulfill an obligation? Fr. Steiner tells us that "Jesus' farewell instructions to His disciples, was a command that we must bear witness to our faith in Him by how we live our lives. What Jesus wants are people who are willing to be martyrs, not necessarily meaning to die, but meaning to take on a little suffering in order to make God's word heard, real and effective".

What sort of witness for Christ are you? What conflict would be brought to light when the live feed cameras are on, especially when you think no one is looking? Are you a witness who would need to lie, twist facts, cut people out of your lives, or be cowardly about doing the right thing because you don't want to deal with the truth of your life?

As we celebrate the fact that we serve a God who won victory over sin and death and is now seated at the right hand of God the Father in heaven, let us by the fervor of our prayers seek guidance and direction from Him, who has already gone where we want to go.
