-- The Pastor's Corner --

My brothers and sisters in Christ, From the movie Jurassic Park, I have always enjoyed the character played by Jeff Goldblum. He played an odd, jittery professor who throughout the movie leads us to believe life always finds a way to continue, or survive. It is a wonderful point to consider especially for those of us, and that actually should be all of us, who believe life is sacred from the moment of natural conception until natural death. In this past week's world news we even heard the true story of a young woman who was found alive, following 18 days stuck in the rubble of a collapsed building. Obviously, a force far greater than any of us is at work as life continues incorruptibly by the power of God.

This weekend we celebrate the reality that by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost, Christ's paschal mystery was brought to its completion. The Spirit's mission of sanctifying humanity, leading humanity to partake of the state of holiness in which Christ's humanity has been established. As we celebrate Pentecost, the Holy Spirit seeks to invade God's creation, take possession of it in the name of God and reign over our hearts.

In last weekend's Pastor's Corner, I asked you to reflect on what sort of witness for Christ are you. This weekend I ask, has the unction of your confirmation dissipated? You should each be screaming a resounding, no! (at least if you are not reading this in church). Jean Cardinal Danielou wrote that "the communication of the Holy

Spirit is accomplished essentially at Pentecost. The Spirit is given to the Church. The Church is the place where the Spirit illumines the intelligence with eternal truth. It seeks to embrace created realities, intelligences, hearts, and wills.” As your pastor, I can’t do much about many of the realities in which we live. As your pastor, I perhaps don’t have much of an affect on your intelligences. However, as your pastor, I hope and pray that I might be able to lead your hearts and will to be more wholly devoted to God, and the edification of His Church. OK, I’ll get to the point. The sign up sheets on the back table in the church continue to look more and more like blank sheets of paper. Time slots for the once monthly Eucharistic adorers are left blank or are filled in with the names of only one or two dedicated parishioners who value that intimate time with the Lord. Again and again we ask for Food pantry volunteers and only the same, virtually worn out individuals make themselves available while others stay home, not caring how that ministry of our parish functions beyond the donation of a few canned goods. In June we will be given the opportunity to take family photos for our new parish directory. Just like with the Bishop’s Appeal, I want and expect 100% participation from our congregants including our frequent visitors, migrants, summer parishioners, and bulwark pillars of our communities. The new directory will simply be a photo footprint of the Catholics who form our portion of the body of Christ. When the history is written, it should be noted that we were here.

Let’s make a greater effort to practice what we preach by our lives, as we reflect on words from the frequently sung hymn: “Lord, You give the great commission: heal the sick and preach the word. Lest the Church neglect its mission and the Gospel go unheard. Help us witness to your purpose with renewed integrity; with the Spirit’s gifts empower us for the work of ministry.” Search your hearts. Get those volunteer slots filled, and pick a time slot for you and or your families to be photographed. AMDG
