-- The Pastor's Corner --

My brothers and sisters in Christ, In my former life as a correction officer I was repeatedly taught there should never be dissention among the ranks of officers. Our uniforms (hence the word) made us appear alike, giving us the ability to maintain custody and control of

inmates whether we were 95 lb. weaklings or 300 lb. gladiators. There was always a special unity within our diversity.

In her wisdom, Holy Mother Church also maintains an amazing unity within her diversity as a result of the specific parameters of the format of the Mass. Outside of the homily, each word, gesture, posture of the clergy and congregation should make it unmistakably clear that one is celebrating the Mass and not just some communal worship service. For example, the congregation should know they are singing hymns to God, not “gangnam style” rap tunes. Likewise the actions, words, and gestures of the priests and other ministers should be indicative of the offices they hold, not of their individual personalities. This helps to insure that even if Father Vatican II or Fr. Tridintine is offering the Mass, it remains a valid celebration.

This weekend our First Communicants will come forward and kneel to receive the Body and Blood of Christ on their tongues, following the preferred manner of reverential reception of so precious a gift. Fr. Ed Steiner reminds us that God desires unity from His people. God desires for us “to be in union with Him and each other. This is the purpose of the vision described in Revelation, that our unity will bring forth the New Jerusalem, the Kingdom.” Congratulations to our First Communicants, the standard bearers for the rest of us and the future of our church.
